Chloe and Rebecca came to the last **Refuel** and wrote about it for their church bulletin:

“Refuel is a gathering of young Christians aged up to 11. One of the helpers told us a story about Joseph and his life. He got some of the children to help act out the scenes. There were 3 different Zones: Family, Choices and Making a Difference. You could choose to do an activity from each Zone to collect 3 different cardboard ‘coats’ that we stuck together to make one 3 dimensional coat. This represented the 3 stages of Joseph’s life. Stage one of Joseph’s life was a multi- coloured coat to represent his family and its problems and the coat his father gave him. The second stage of his life was a white coat to represent when he was a servant. The third was a silver coat to represent him being important and happy. There were games at the beginning so we played with people that we didn’t know. There was food like chocolate and drinks that we could get at any time. The songs that they do at Refuel are very good, because they have actions to them and they are quite lively. All of the people who helped out were really nice and kind and there were a lot of teenagers helping out! It was fun and we discovered that God is always with us! We are going again in March.”
