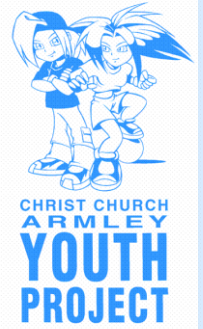




# FOOD CO-OP LEAD WORKER
